Student Fee Schedule 2019-20**

A participant who is not a D20 student or not a D20 resident will pay 150% of the fee. The fee for 2019-20 is \$98. Consult with the school principal for fee waiver information	Student cannot participate in intramural or interscholastic football

A participant who is not a D20 student or not a D20 resident will pay 150% of the fee. The fee for 2019-20 is \$68. Consult with the school principal for fee waiver information	Student cannot participate in intramural or interscholastic athletics

School Fee	Yearbook	\$60 per year book	To cover a portion of the cost of producing and printing a yearbook. <i>Fee to be determined once a sponsor and publisher are identified</i>	Student will not receive a yearbook.
Tuition	Sixth Grade High Trails (4 days)	\$285 per session	To cover a portion of the cost of the 6th grade outdoor high trails experience. Cost covers curriculum, supervision, transportation, lodging, and food	Payment of fee is required for participation. Students who do not participate in the program will be offered a comparable alternative at reduced or no cost
User Fee	Musical instrument rental: Non-percussion	\$50 per semester per instrument	To cover a portion of the cost associated with instrument maintenance and purchase/lease	Student will not be issued school-owned instruments. Students may bring personally owned equipment to avoid rental fee
User Fee	Musical instrument rental: Percussion	\$25 per semester	To cover a portion of the cost associated with instrument maintenance and purchase/lease	Student will not be issued school-owned instruments. Students may bring personally owned equipment to waive rental fee
